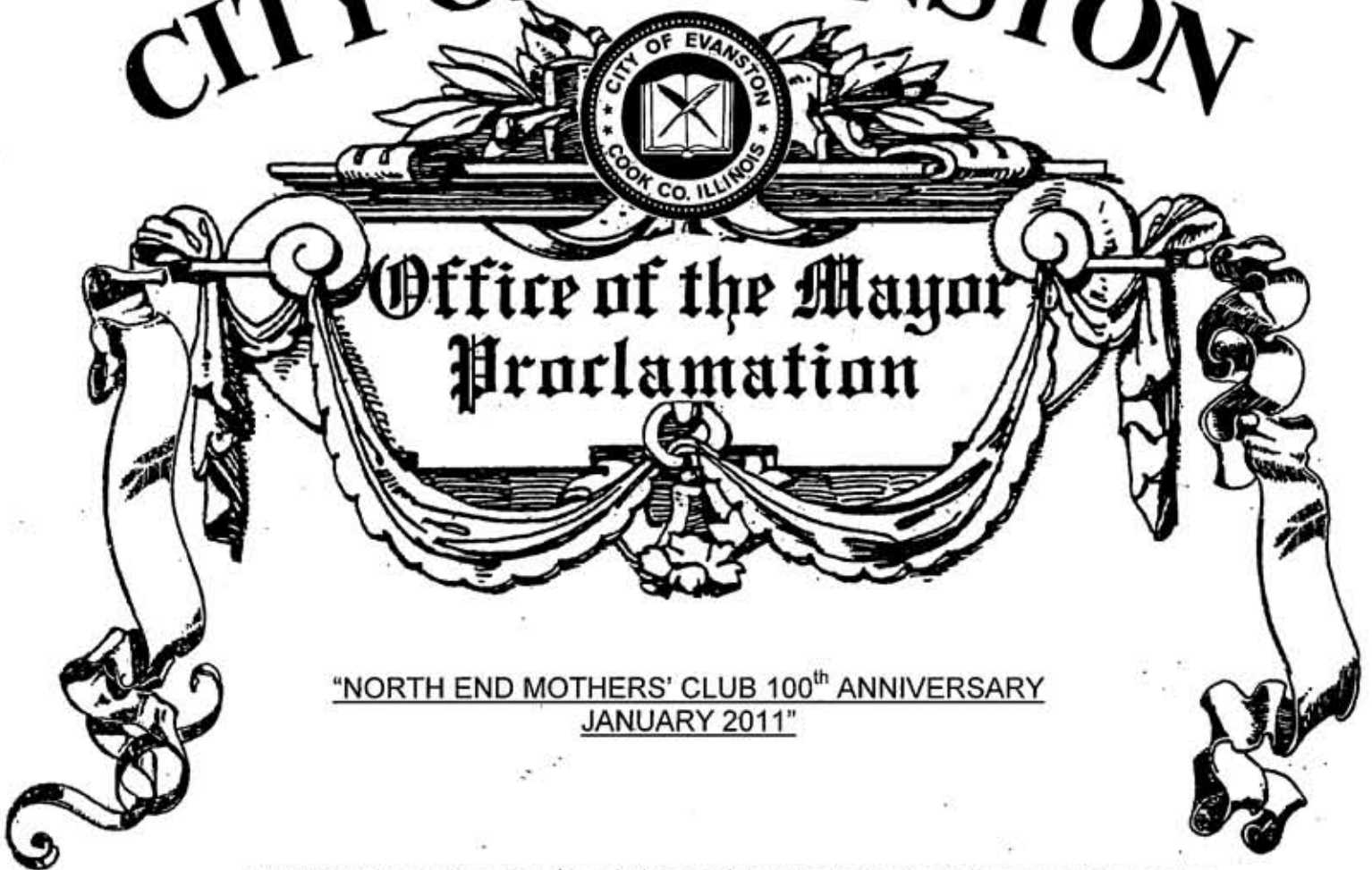


# CITY OF EVANSTON

*WHEREAS*, the North End Mothers' Club is celebrating its Centennial year providing service to youth in the Evanston community; and

*WHEREAS*, the North End Mothers' Club was founded in 1911 by a group of Evanston women vitally interested in the children and youth of Evanston; and

*WHEREAS*, the purpose of the Club is to promote and advance educational, charitable, civic, health, and welfare activities in Evanston and support and assist organizations dedicated to these purposes; and

*WHEREAS*, the Club awards three scholarships to Evanston Township High School seniors, two of which are dedicated to female graduates; and

*WHEREAS*, since 1917 the Club has sponsored Fortnightly Dance Classes for all 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades and approximately half of the proceeds are returned through donations to organization in Evanston supporting Evanston children; and


*WHEREAS*, in 1922 the Club founded the Evanston Fourth of July Association to provide safe, organized activities for children after a local boy was injured setting off a firecracker; and


*WHEREAS*, in 2010 the Club donated over \$25,000 to District 65 Kids and School Supplies, ETHS After Midnight, The Fourth of July Association, Evanston YWCA Women's Shelter, Keep Evanston Beautiful, McGaw YMCA, Evanston School Children's Clothing Association, Infant Welfare Society, Evanston Public Library Friends, TED Fund, Evanston in School Music Association, and The Child Care Center of Evanston:
